Description: The Youth Program facilitator will work closely with the Volunteer Coordinator to mentor, support and supervise up to 10 youth taking part in the volunteer program. You will excel in this position if you are passionate about working with youth, have great interpersonal skills, like to take initiative, and are flexible.

- Support youth in their volunteer activities.
- Plan and execute tasks related to the youth volunteer program.
- Liaise with the volunteer coordinator to schedule youth in various volunteer roles across the organization.
- Supervise and mentor youth in the volunteer program.
- Develop positive relationships with youth in the program.
- Facilitate life and employment skills workshops for youth in the volunteer program.

- Document and write reports regarding program delivery and outcomes.

What you will bring:

- A positive, engaging and solutions focused attitude to the work.
- A strong desire to work in a community setting with those experiencing the impacts of poverty.
- 1+ years of recent experience in planning and delivering youth programs.
- Understanding and knowledge of issues facing youth in Dartmouth North/HRM.
- Understanding of strength-based approach in programming.
- Experience in group presentation, facilitation and team building.
- Ability to document progress on goals and strategies.
- A warm and supportive manner when engaging with volunteers and/or other staff is a must.
- Experience supervising people is considered an asset.
